



DMS - Deceleration Management system

DMS is the Danish Customs Agency's new solution for customs declarations, which includes Import, Export and Shipment in one and the same solution.

The first part of Import, which supports e-commerce and postal shipments, has already been implemented and Export and postal shipments will go live in the spring of 2024, while the second part of Import will be implemented throughout 2024 and 2025 depending on the mode of transport.

After 1st May 2024, it will no longer be possible to submit declarations in the current E-Export.

The EU places greater demands on the amount of information to be submitted in declarations and notifications. Therefore, the new DMS solution contains text boxes for completely new information as well as the division of previous boxes into several new boxes. In addition, the definition of the declaration types in the new DMS changes from numeric to alphanumeric.

The data set for each entry changes, which means you must select the correct entry type in advance. The declaration types are:

- A declaration, which are lodged directly at the customs office of exit.
- B declarations, which are lodged at the customs office of export (the office of dispatch in e-Export).
- C declarations, which include the 'simplified export declaration' scheme. It replaces the previous declaration type 21, simplified export declaration.

Shipment declarations will in the new DMS Shipment become D-Declarations.

The requirements for commercial invoices are unchanged in that they must still at least contain information about:

- Seller
- Buyer
- Number of packages
- Gross and net weight
- Description of goods
- HS code
- Country of origin
- Incoterms
- Preference declaration, if applicable
